



Oswego County Discount Rx Card Program

- *Any resident* of Oswego County, regardless of age, can participate in the Oswego County Discount Drug Card program. The program is designed to help uninsured and underinsured residents, including those who are self-employed.
- The program is a partnership of the Oswego County Legislature and ProAct, Inc., a pharmaceutical benefits company.
- *There is no cost* to the Oswego County government and no cost to participants.
- The Discount Card can be used at *any participating pharmacy in Oswego County*, and at pharmacies nationwide.
- The Discount Program covers all prescription medications, brand name or generic.
- Participants save an average of:
10-20% on brand drugs
20-50% on generic drugs
- Discount Cards are available at participating pharmacies and the following Oswego County offices:
